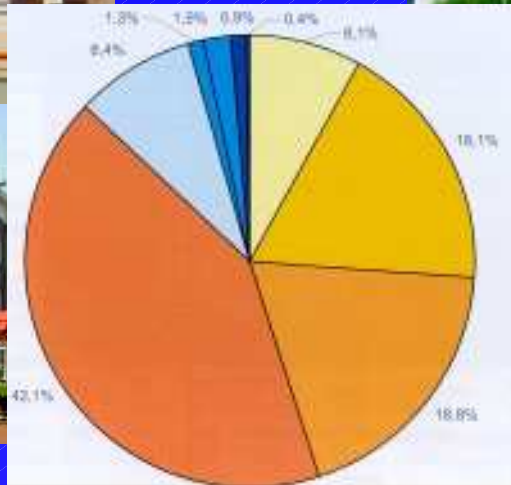

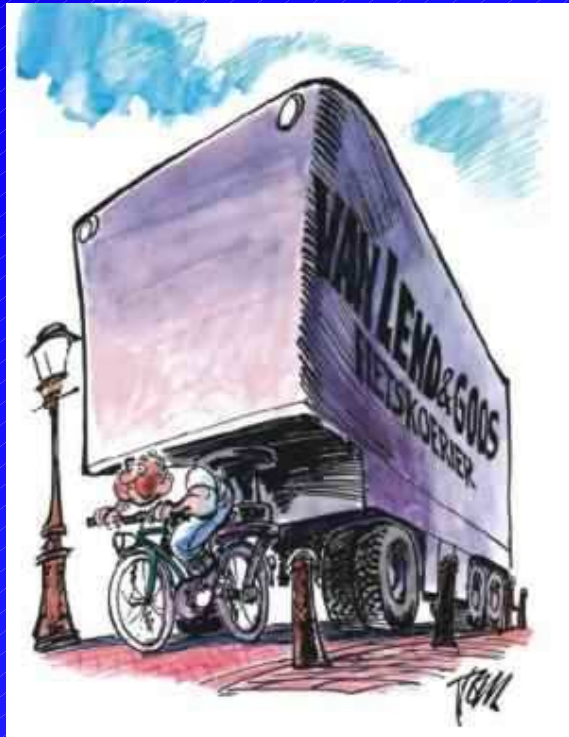


Distribution of goods nowadays
