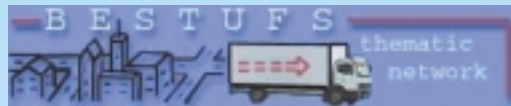

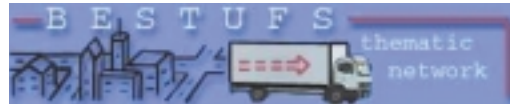

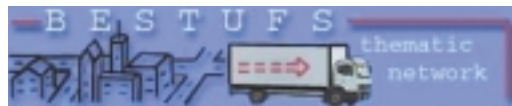

PAYMENT DETAILS

9. **Freightview Limited** reserves the right to change the content of the programme that may be due to circumstances beyond our control.

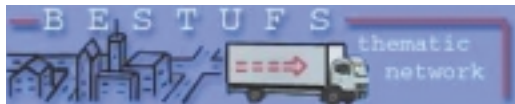

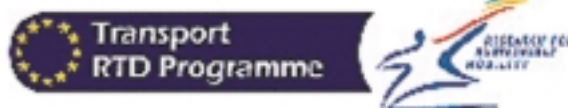
